

### WOMEN'S CLUB GROUPS 2011-2012

### BUNCO:

These groups are very popular and have membership limits. Bunco is a dice game which is easy and fun to play. The groups meet monthly at members homes. Group I meets the 1<sup>st</sup> Thursday of every month and Group II meets the 3<sup>rd</sup> Tuesday every month. You may sign up to become a regular member or a substitute.

### BOOK SWAPS:

A Book Swap is when each person brings Paperback or Hardback novels that they would like to Swap and leaves with an equal number of "new to you" books to read. Cost: ZERO dollars!!!! Swaps are held every 3-4 months.

### **CREATIVE COOKING:**
