encourage all Brook Park neighbors to remove snow and ice in a responsible and timely fashion from sidewalks and driveways and in accordance with Borough and Township Snow Removal Ordinances. It is against ordinances to blow or shovel snow into

Borough and Township streets. Doing so could result in a fine. Parking in the streets during or after a snow fall may also be limited or prohibited. Beyond the laws, its common courtesy and a matter of simple safety to keep your sidewalks cleared.
