**Chai Syrup**

2 chai tea bags  
1.5 cups sugar  
2 cups water  
Combine ingredients in a saucepan. Boil, stirring regularly. Simmer for five minutes, double-strain, chill.

**Never Kiss And Tell**

1oz Ketel One Grapefruit & Rose vodka  
1oz chai syrup  
1oz fresh lime juice  
1oz 100% black cherry juice  
2dash Angostura orange bitters

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
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
