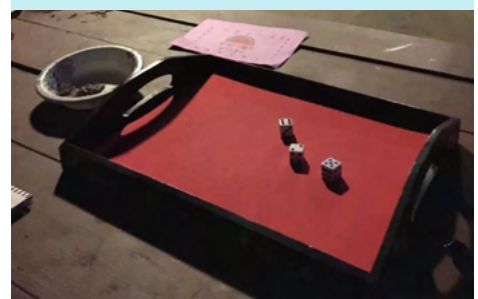

## Traditional Social Groups

Below, you will find a list of long standing Brook Park social groups. Most typically meet once a month. What is written here is what has happened in the past. ### 6 Pack & A Snack

Akin to happy hour, this group is open to all 21+. Participants BYOB and snacks and enjoy each other's company.

### Book Swap

This group has traditionally met once a month. Members bring books they have finished, sharing plots and swap with others during meetings.

### Bunco

Bunco is a fun and easy dice game. Traditionally, there have been two bunco groups, one that meets once a month on Tuesdays and one that meets once a month on Thursdays. The Thursday group is a long standing, established group that is not currently taking new members.

### Creative Cooking

This women only group meets once a month on Wednesdays to play with food. Monthly meetings have included presentations on wine and wine pairings, pasta making demonstration, mixed drink instructions, dinners, pot lucks, dinner out and many, many more.

### Kid Connection

This is a neighborhood play group that has met once a month. It is a great opportunity for kids to meet, socialize and play as well as their caregivers.

## Traditional Brook Park Events

### Easter Egg Hunt

This is a traditional Easter egg hunt where participants, divided by age, hunt for filled plastic Easter eggs. This is usually accompanied by small games, cookies and snacks.

### Scavenger Hunt

Residents put out fun or quirky items and participants can roam the neighborhood over the scavenger hunt weekend to find where those items have been "hidden." Finders participate for prizes.

### Neighborhood Wide Garage Sale

2023 is the year of our neighborhood wide garage sale!

### Plant Swap

This is a time for residents to come together with plants from their yard they no longer love or need to be divided. Participants can browse what everyone brings and trade, take or give what they are interested in. This was once an annual event, but has not been held in a while. There has been interest in seeing it return.

### Adult Fall Social

This is another event that has been dormant for a bit, but there has been interest in seeing it revitalized. Historically, it was an adult Halloween party, but has been suggested it reawaken as Oktoberfest or brewery crawl.

### Halloween Parade

Participants dress up and parade along the designated parade route. Typically the parade is led by a local fire company and the NA band. There are often small games and cookies at the end.

### Bonfire

Traditionally held in December, although covid has forced it to move around the calendar a bit, this is a traditional bonfire with cookies, socializing and sometimes Christmas caroling.

### Santa Visits

Santa visits residents' homes to talk with the kids. We still have the Santa suit!

### Luminaries

Luminary kits go on sale in November for residents to purchase and light on Christmas Eve. Kits include 10 bags, 10 candles and sand.

- Relevant municipal information from McCandless or Franklin Park
- Youth offering services (babysitting, snow shoveling, etc)
- Residents looking for services & recommendations

Emails will **not** be sent for the following:

- Political advertising (this does not include alerts if polling places change, etc. Rather emails will not be sent favoring or informing about any candidate or issue).
- Items for sale or free. These should be posted on the [Brook Park Market Place Facebook page](#). A link to the Facebook page will be in every month's newsletter also.
- Ongoing products or services. These can be advertised for free in the newsletter for any paid Civic Association member.

We are grateful to have the neighborhood email platform as a way to easily communicate with residents, but wish to continue using it in a manner that best suits residents needs and wants. Thank you for your cooperation and support.
